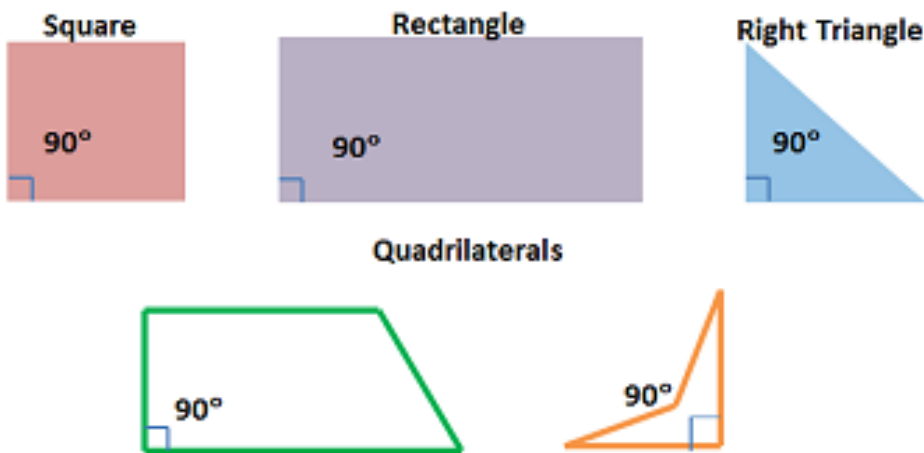

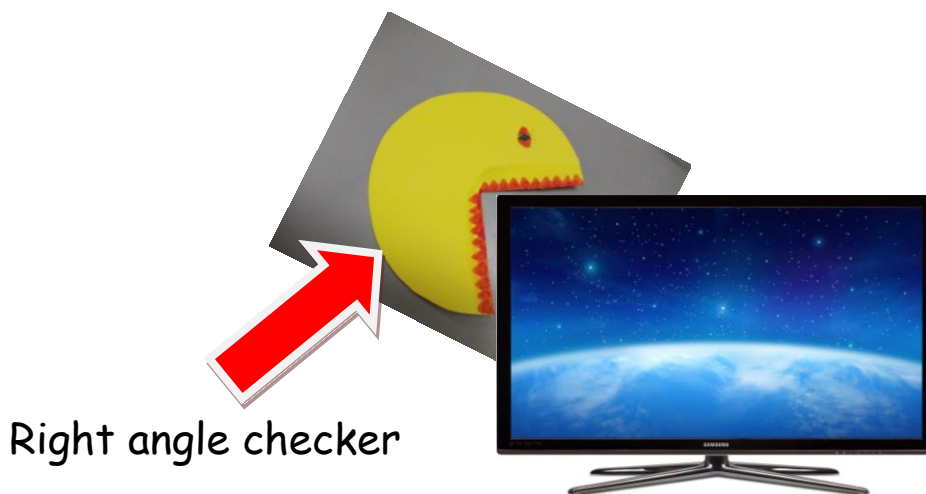

## Mental Maths - Practise your x3, x4 tables - Challenge x8

This week we have been busy learning about angles. Angles are formed when two straight lines meet each other. When two straight lines meet each other making an 'L' shape this angle is called a right angle. Often right angles are marked with a square as shown on the shape examples below.
