Spelling tip: Adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words of more than one syllable

Key Vocabulary:

Success Criteria:

1. If the last syllable of a word is **stressed** and ends with **one consonant letter** which has just **one vowel letter before it**, the **final consonant letter** is **double** before adding any ending **beginning with a vowel letter** is added.
2. The **consonant letter** is **not doubled** if the syllable is **unstressed**.

Examples:

Forget → Forgetting

Begin → Beginning

Prefer → Preferred
